

**RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE PAKISTAN BAR COUNCIL IN ITS
199TH (SPECIAL) MEETING HELD ON 09-02-2013 AT LAHORE.**

RESOLUTION

“Whereas the Pakistan Bar Council while showing dissatisfaction to the procedure of appointment of Judges to the Superior Courts in its 193rd and 197th meetings has passed unanimous Resolutions in respect of nomination of a Member to the Judicial Commission of Pakistan, further resolving that the nominees of the Provincial Bar Councils and the Pakistan Bar Council in the Judicial Commission are required to be effectively and meaningfully consulted with respect to appointment of Judges in the Superior Courts, particularly such consultation are required to take place before the initiation of names by respective Chief Justices and even thereafter.

Whereas in its special (199th) meeting, the Pakistan Bar Council has also resolved to propose amendments in Rules of the Judicial Commission and for the time being the Pakistan Bar Council has decided not to nominate a Member to the Judicial Commission of Pakistan.

Therefore, it is unanimously resolved that in view of the aforesaid decision of the Pakistan Bar Council and in the interest of judicial institutions, the nominees of the Provincial Bar Councils to the Judicial Commission are requested not to participate in meetings of the Judicial Commission till the matter is finally decided by the Pakistan Bar Council.”
