**ORDER**

Both the Punjab University and Bahauddin Zakria University are represented by learned counsel who acknowledges that the students already admitted in the affiliated colleges deserve sympathetic consideration. However, they state that the standards prescribed for law colleges in the judgment of this Court are being applied by the Universities. Be that as it may, the matter regarding enforcement of the new standards with respect to the three years LL.B course for which the last date of admission was 31.12.2018 ought to be applied by the Universities in a fair and reasonable manner so that students already admitted in the course do not suffer on account of a sudden imposition of new regulations and standards. In this behalf, the Universities are at liberty to grant further time for compliance to the affiliated colleges that are deficient in their infrastructure and resources to meet the standards set by the Universities. The decision in this regard shall be taken by the competent authority of the respective University within one week. The matter is fixed on 15.1.2019 when a fair and workable solution shall be presented by the Universities to the Court.
